Which type of investor?

- Is there/can there be an (emerging) revenue stream?
- Can the goal be framed in generally accepted investment themes (e.g. Financial Inclusion, Energy access, rainforest protection) and linked to the SDGs?
- 3. Is it possible to set and track clear, consistent and comparable metrics for impact tracking?
- 4. How strong and clearly foreseeable are the financial returns?
- 5. What is the tradeoff between financial return and impact?
- 6. What are comparable or rival products/services and what does the market look like?
- 7. What does the investment offer the fund in its portfolio?
